Greeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Honourable adjudicators, principal, teachers and fellow students,</li> </ul>
Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Today, our debate motion is ‘Strict teachers produce better students’.</li> <li>- Over the years, there has been considerable discussion of how to produce outstanding students.</li> <li>- Many educators tend to believe that setting strict rules and pushing students to excel are the only ways to make students successful.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Our team strongly opposes this motion and the arguments are presented as follows.</li> </ul>
Body	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Strict teachers do not guarantee the positive effect on students</li> <li>- may feel frustrated by strict teaching</li> <li>- discourage students from learning</li> <li>- probably end up hating school</li> <li>- Strict teaching may backfire and students may have terrible academic results because of their rebellion.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Strict teachers can inflict mental problems on their students.</li> <li>- Over-strict teaching and punishment can hurt students’ confidence.</li> <li>- may lead to psychological problems</li> <li>- According to a survey, over 70% of Hong Kong students have even suffered depression.</li> <li>- Strict teachers should not be advocated to worsen the problem.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Strict teachers can stop students from all-round development.</li> <li>- tend to constrict students’ daily activities</li> <li>- fail to explore their own potential and interest</li> <li>- students’ development should be well-rounded</li> </ul>

Conclusion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- To sum up, over-strict teaching can cause several problems including discouraging learning, mental problems and disturbing well-rounded development.</li></ul>
