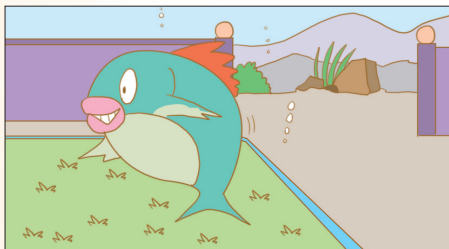

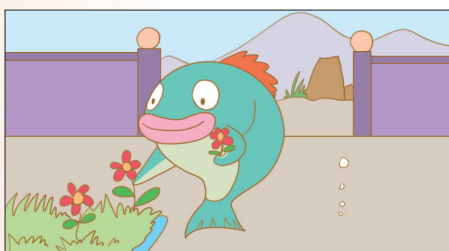

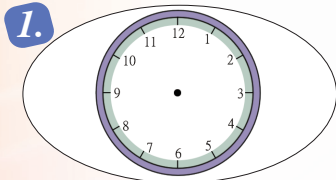

Alex finds Mr Old's old clocks in a cave. Help him write the time of the clock using symbols on the code paper below. (Questions – What time...?)

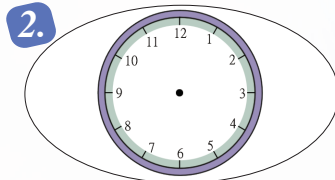
