The thief is neither a girl nor a woman.

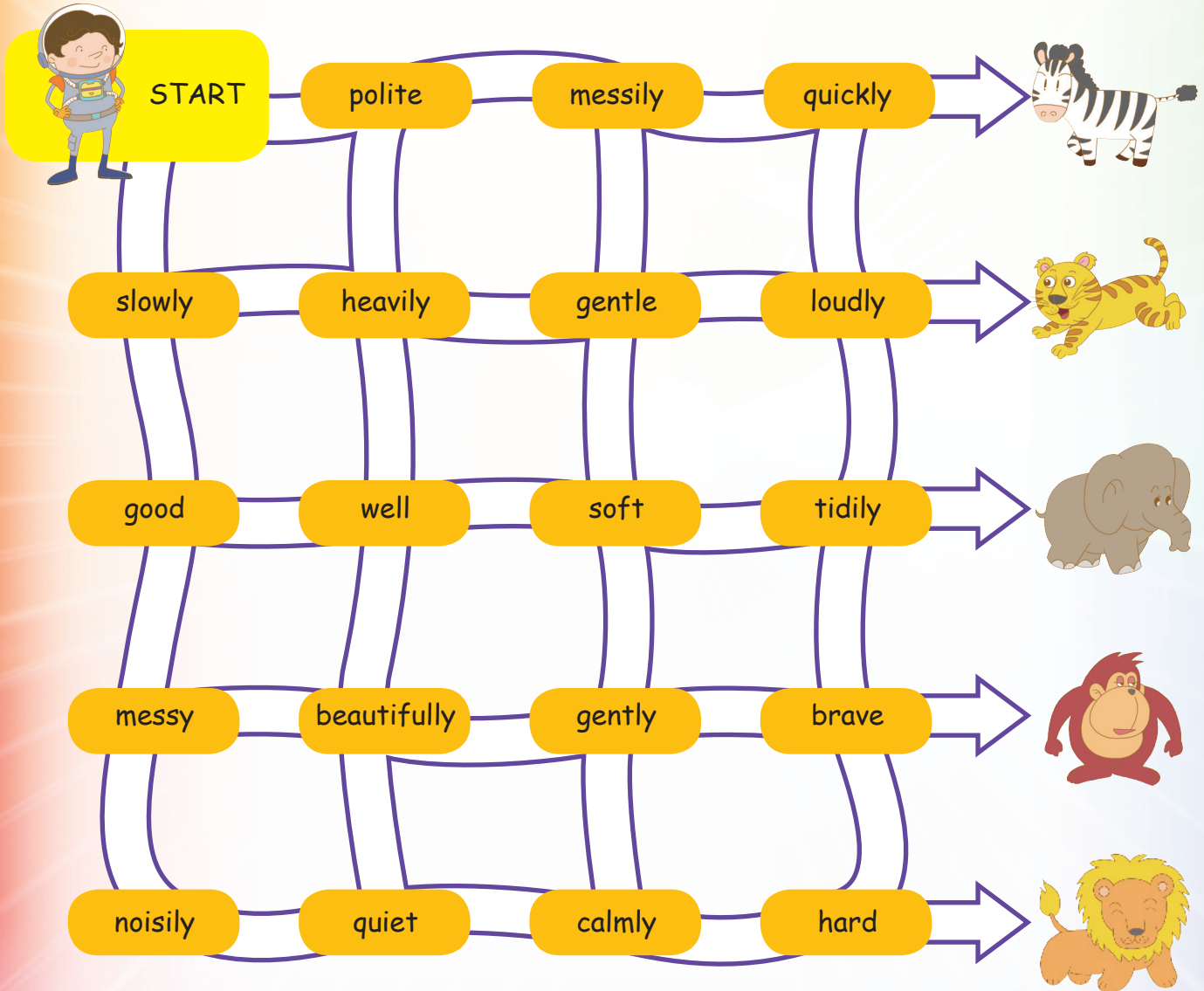
The thief is a man who is fat and with a big belly.

My Birthday Presents

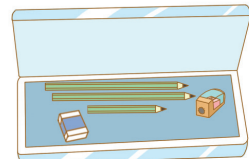
What presents did Philip get on his birthday? Read what he says and fill in the blanks with the correct words. (Subject, object and reflexive pronouns)
