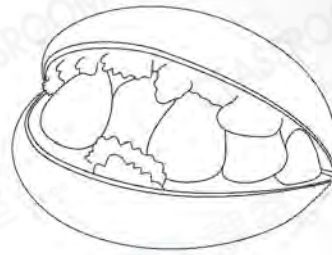

6. Enjoy this festive snack with your friends!

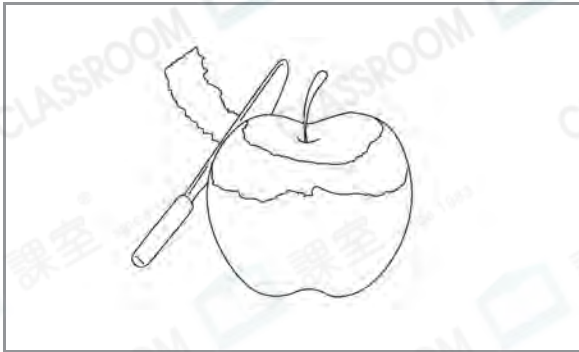

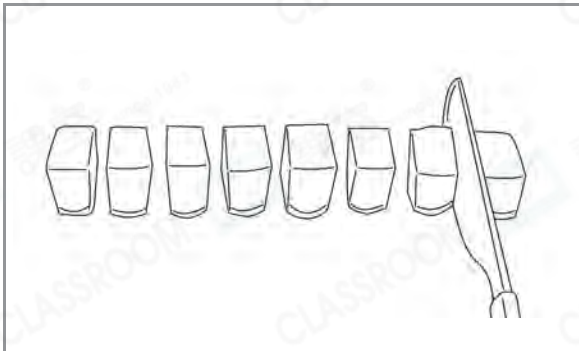
