#### **Ingredients:**

5. Put all the fruit in a large bowl and mix it.
6. Pour the orange juice on top of the salad. It stops the apple from going brown.
7. Refrigerate the fruit salad until you serve it.

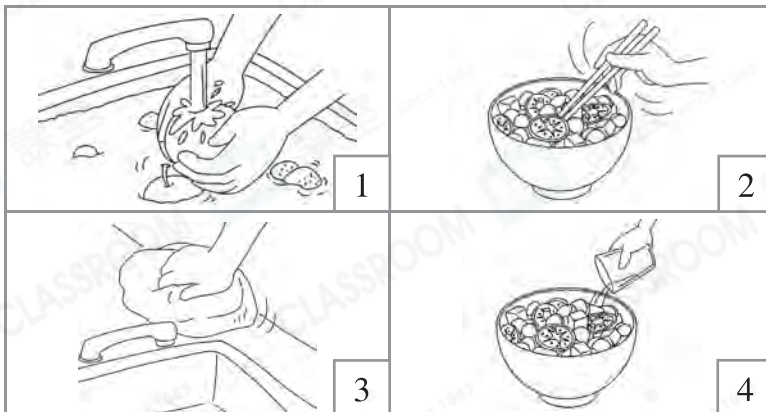

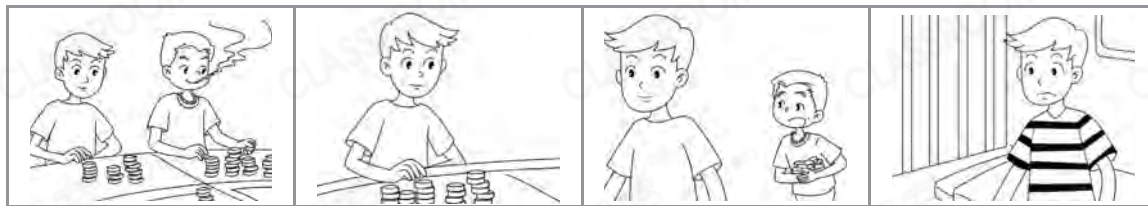

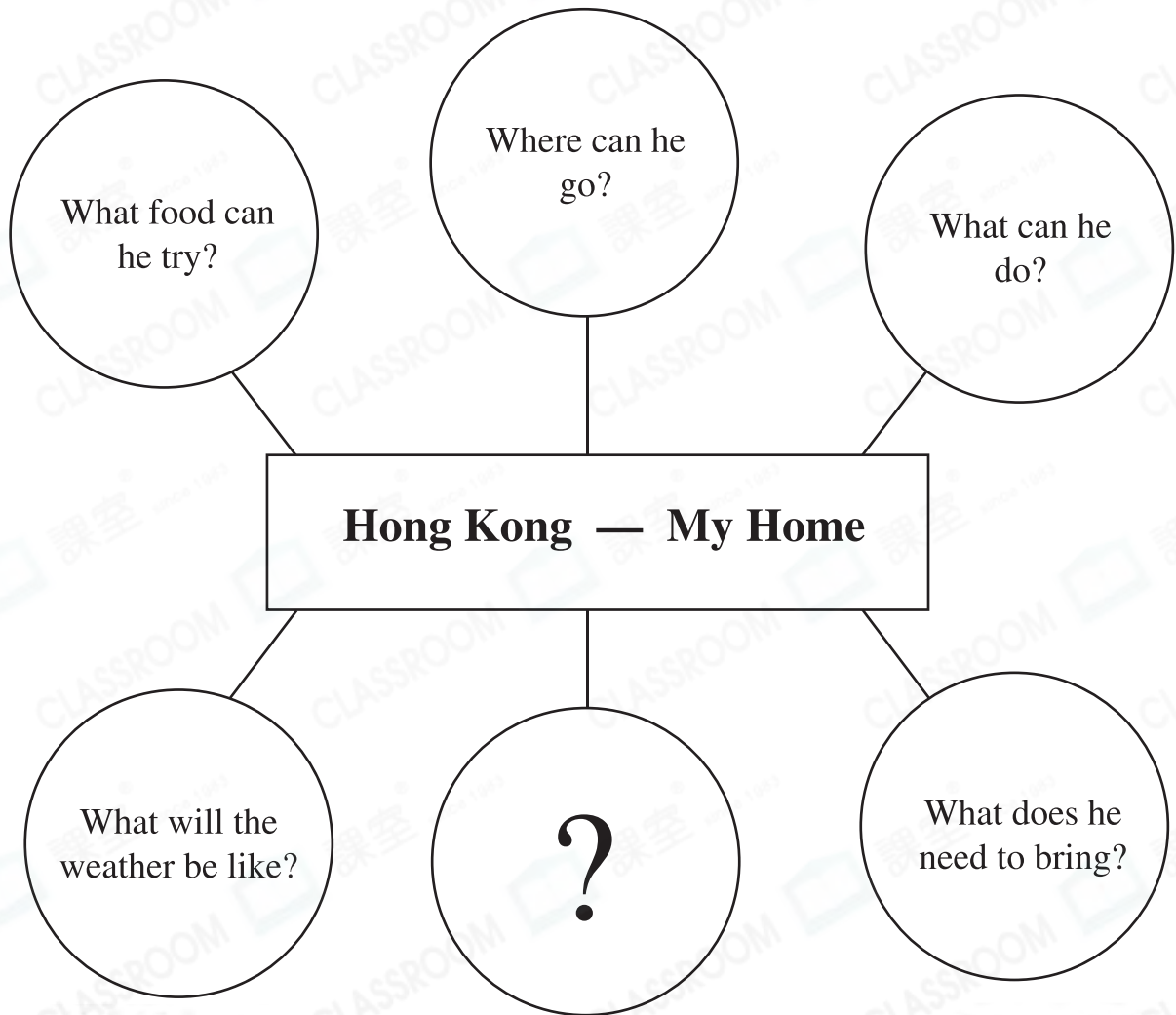
