

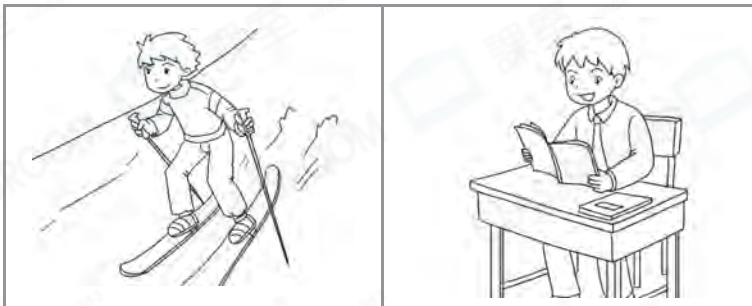

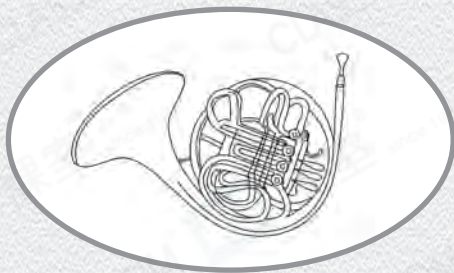

### Lovely Sounds

#### Flutes

Flutes are silver instruments. They are held horizontally just under the mouth. People blow air across the mouthpiece and press the finger keys of this type of instrument to produce sounds. Early flutes were made from animal bones that were at least 37,000 years old.

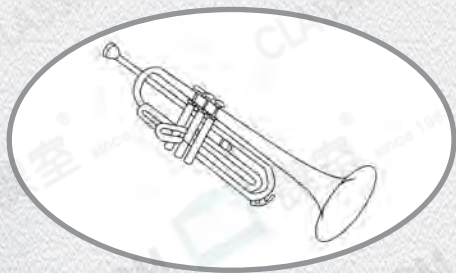


#### French Horns

Modern French horns were invented based on early hunting horns. Horns were first used as musical instruments during the 16<sup>th</sup> century.

#### Saxophones

Saxophones are relatively young instruments. They were exhibited to the world for the first time in 1841.



#### Trumpets

Trumpets are one of the earliest instruments. The first trumpet was very different from the modern trumpet. In the past, people used hollow materials like animal horns as trumpets.
