Fish and Chips

Fish and chips is a world-famous dish. It is a hot dish made up of fried fish and French fries. The word 'chips' is the British word for 'French fries'. Many people may believe that the British came up with this dish. However, the idea of enjoying fried fish and French fries together actually came from Spain.



In England, the first fish and chip shop was opened in the 1860s. The shop attracted a lot of people and they enjoyed the dish a lot. Years later, fish and chip shops became more common because people could catch fish easier. By the 1930s, there were over 35,000 shops in England! To help others find a good local fish and chip shop, the British later set up an annual award for the best fish and chip shop!

To make fish and chips, fry a white fish fillet in a deep frying pan. Fry the fish fillet until it becomes golden and crispy. Then, peel a few fresh potatoes, cut them into strips and deep-fry **them** for around ten minutes. Fish and chip shops in Britain usually sprinkle the dish with salt before serving. They also serve it with mushy peas.

These days, fish and chips is still a very popular dish at restaurants and seaside resorts. It is also a popular takeaway choice for many people. Who can resist a golden fish fillet and crispy French fries?
