Guidelines at the Beach and Public Swimming Pool

✓ Dos:

- Only barbecue in the barbecue area → clean up the area after using
- Put rubbish into rubbish bins → sort the rubbish, if possible, before putting it into different recycling bins
- Keep the changing rooms clean and tidy
- Wash yourself before entering the pool
- Rest for 2 to 3 hours after eating before swimming

✗ Don'ts:

- Bring dogs to the beach → they can spread diseases to humans when their hair and remains, which often contain germs, are left behind on the beach
- Throw sand or stones at others
- Swim right after eating → may develop stomach pain when your stomach starts digesting the food. The stomach pain increases your chance of drowning in the water
- Litter → marine animals often mistake rubbish like plastic waste for food
- Smoke and dump cigarettes → they cannot be broken down completely in the sand and can release toxic chemicals into the water
- Enter the pool when you feel sick → may spread diseases to others
