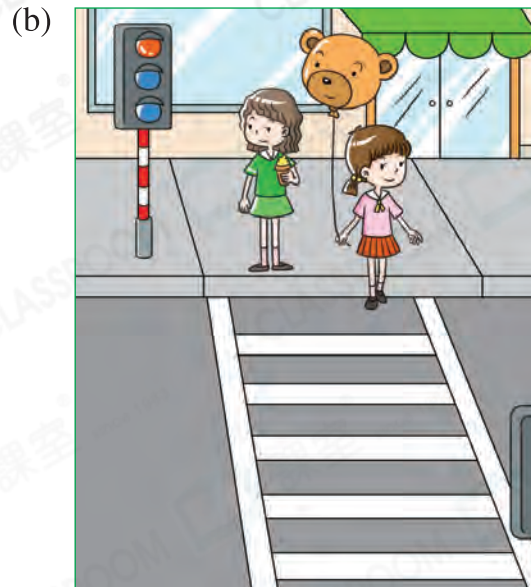


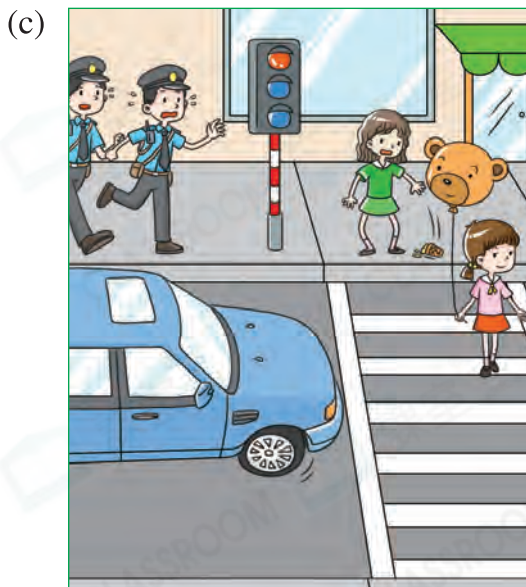

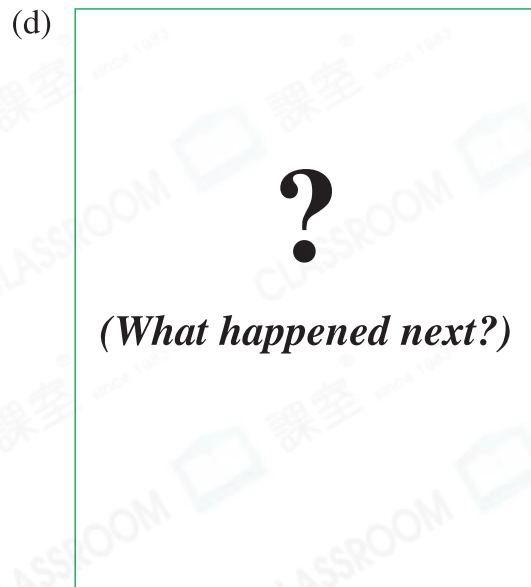

pedestrian crossing / pavement



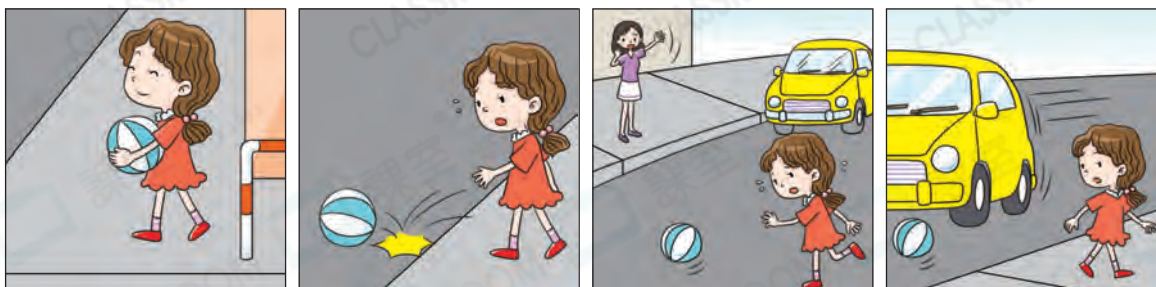
