Pasta is one of the most commonly eaten foods in the world. Some people think that Italians invented pasta, while some think that pasta is a kind of Asian noodles. However, it is still widely believed that Marco Polo brought the idea of pasta to Italy from China in the 13th century.

Thousands of years ago, noodles were common in Asia. Asians mainly used rice to make flour for their noodles. When Italians knew about noodles, they tried to make flour from wheat. Soon, it became the pasta we know today. Because of its low price, pasta became one of the main foods for people in Italy. The climate of Italy is suitable for growing vegetables and herbs.
