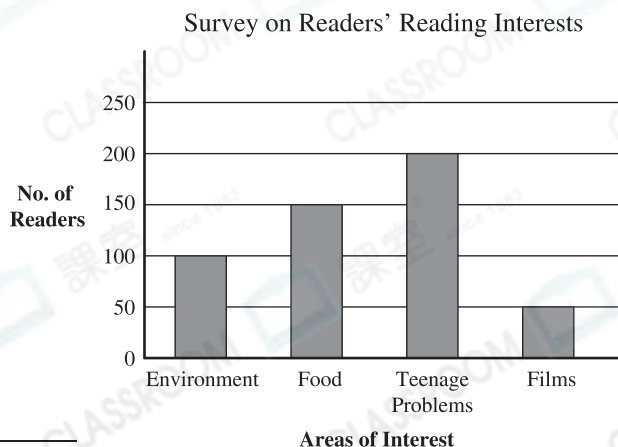

## The Gift of School

For millions of children, going to school is just a dream. Their parents cannot afford to send them to school. **They** cannot go to school but need to work to help their families.

Children's Education is a charity set up in 2006 to help poor children go to school. We provide money to cover the school fees, textbooks, stationery and daily meals. We also make sure each child gets a good lunch at school. We help them make the most of learning. Children cannot study well if they are weak because of hunger. They find it too hard to concentrate.

Children's Education helps children like Keung. Keung is 12 and lives with his family in a small wooden house in a remote farming area in Henan Province, China. Keung's father was a labourer who died in a traffic accident when Keung was only two. His mother grew vegetables to feed the whole family. The rest were sold at the local market for only 1,000 yuan a year. She was too poor to send her three children to school and they never had money to see a doctor or a dentist. Keung, the youngest one, had bad teeth and always had a cough. He was very thin. His mother was worried but there was nothing she could do.

When Children's Education heard about Keung's life, we paid for him so that he could go to school. We also paid for his medical fees. Now Keung has a better life. He wants to **make a difference** in his village by being a doctor when he grows up. He hopes that he can help the poor people in his village.
