He decides to let five children visit his factory. Charlie is lucky. He finds the golden ticket!

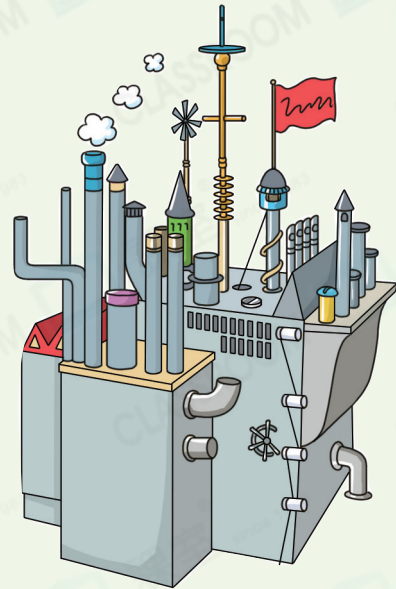
