Today Mum and Dad go to visit Grandpa and Grandma. I stay at home with Momo because I have a Maths test on Monday.

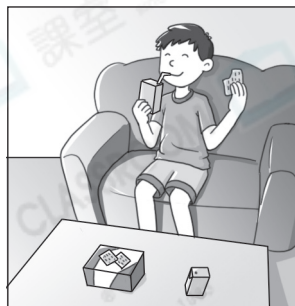
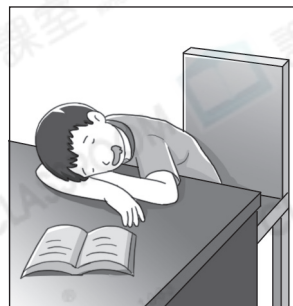
