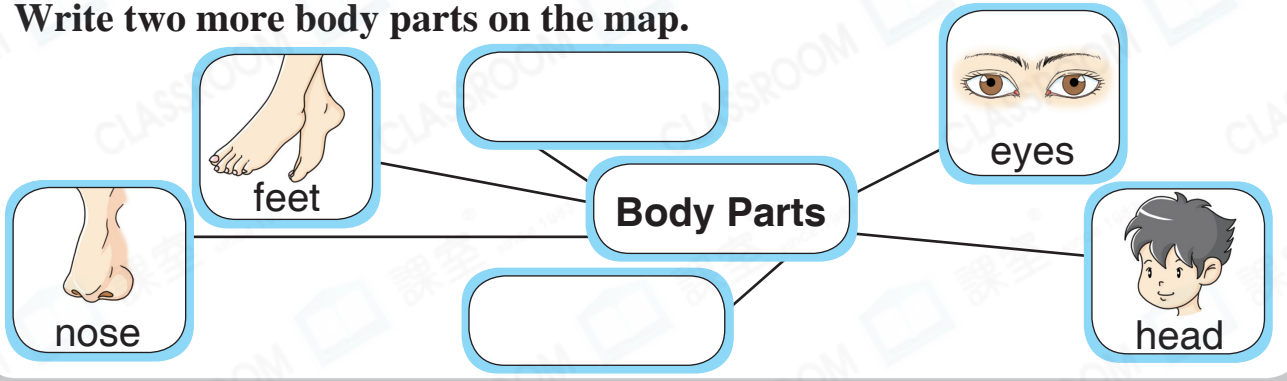

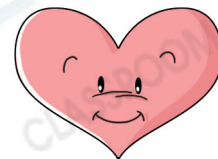
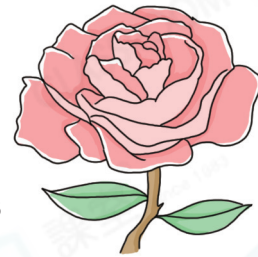
Red is an apple,

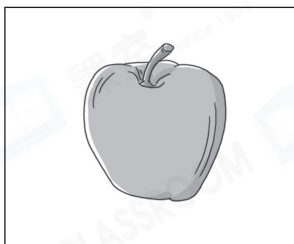

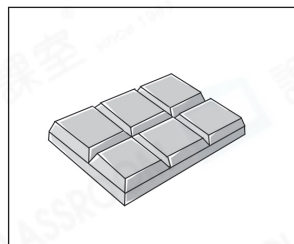

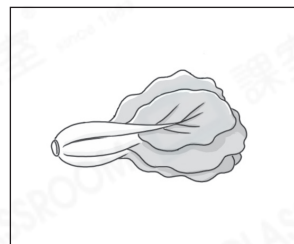
