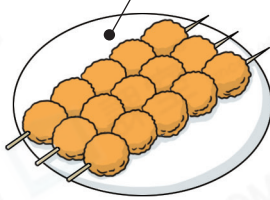
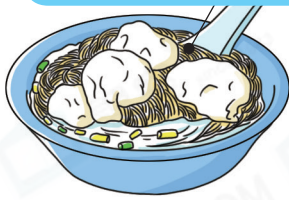


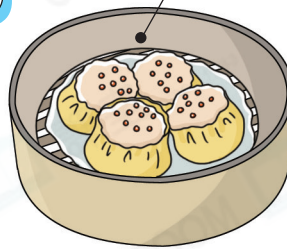

People say on the ferry ride.

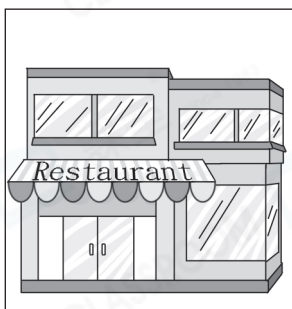

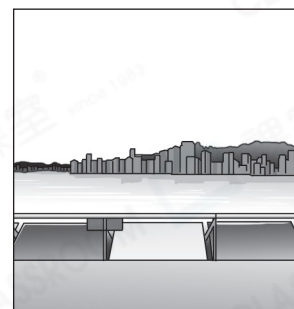
