

## Read the play.

Characters:

Anne and Peter : Primary 5 students

Buttercup : a fairy, 6 years old

## Scene I

[Anne and Peter are wearing school uniform. Anne sees Peter.]

[Peter is looking at a piece of old paper and does not notice Anne.]

Anne : Peter! (runs towards Peter and taps on his shoulder) Peter!

Peter : (shocked) Oh, Anne! You scared me!

Anne : What are you looking at?

Peter : I found this yesterday in my grandpa's drawer near his bed! Look! (shows Anne the piece of paper)

Anne : What is this? Oh, it's a treasure map!

Peter : Shh! Don't let anyone hear us. Let's find the treasure together.

Anne : (speaks quietly) OK. But where is the treasure?

Peter : Look at these words on the map. They look so strange.

[Buttercup flies towards Anne and lands on her head.]

Anne : (touches her head) Oh! Something is on my head!

Buttercup : Hello, Peter and Anne.

Peter : It's a fairy!

Buttercup : These are fairy words! (points at the map) The treasure is in Black Forest.

Anne : Where is it?
