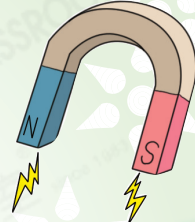


Read the joke.

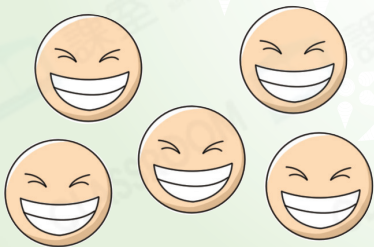
