

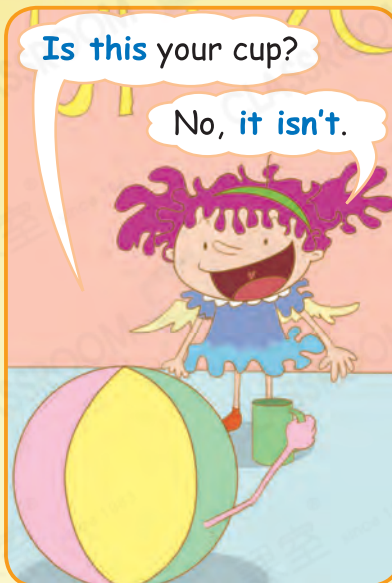

## Are These Our Presents?

Questions – *Is this...?* / *Are these...?*



### Grammar in Focus

We use 'Is this...?' or 'Are these...?' to ask if something belongs to someone.

<b>Is this</b>	your pen?
	her cup?

Yes, <b>it is</b> .
No, <b>it is not (isn't)</b> .

<b>Are these</b>	my shoes?
	their boxes?

Yes, <b>they are</b> .
No, <b>they are not (aren't)</b> .
