### Grammar in Focus

We use the following expressions to tell the directions.

<b>Go out of</b> the MTR station.	The bus stop is <b>next to</b> the Chinese restaurant.
<b>Walk along</b> the road.	The bus stop is <b>opposite</b> the school.
<b>Go / Walk straight ahead.</b>	The cafe is <b>at the end of</b> the road.
<b>Walk across</b> the road.	<b>Turn left / right into</b> Golden Road.
<b>Walk through</b> the park.	The sports centre is <b>on your left / right</b> .



Mistakes Corner

✓ The store is **on** your left. ✗ The store is **in** your left.

- The restaurant is ( **A** at / **B** on ) your right.
- The church is ( **A** on / **B** in ) your left.
