Grammar in Focus

We use 'Whose' to ask which person owns something.

Whose	pen	is this?
	books	are these?

We use possessive pronouns to show that something belongs to someone.

It's	mine.	Hers	is / are	blue.
They're	ours.	Theirs	is / are	

my thing(s) → mine
your thing(s) → yours

his thing(s) → his
her thing(s) → hers

our thing(s) → ours
their thing(s) → theirs



✓ My hair is longer than yours. ✗ My hair is longer than your.
