Grammar in Focus

We use the present perfect tense to talk about the present result of a past action. We use 'yet' in questions and negative sentences.

Have	they	eaten the food	yet?
Has	she	read the book	

No,	they	haven't	eaten the food	yet.
	she	hasn't	read the book	

We use 'already' and 'just' in positive sentences.

Yes,	they	have	already	eaten the food.
	she	has	just	read the book.
