Grammar in Focus

An infinitive is the base form of a verb. We often use 'to' before an infinitive. Some verbs are followed by the to-infinitive:

forget	need	remember	promise
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Bobby forgot **to bring** his English book to school.

Some verbs are followed by an object and the to-infinitive.

Mum **asked** me **to finish** my homework before dinner.

A gerund is formed by adding '-ing' to a verb. We often use a gerund after the preposition 'for'.

Thank you **for giving** me some useful advice.

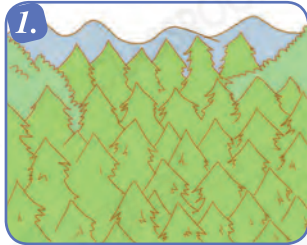
