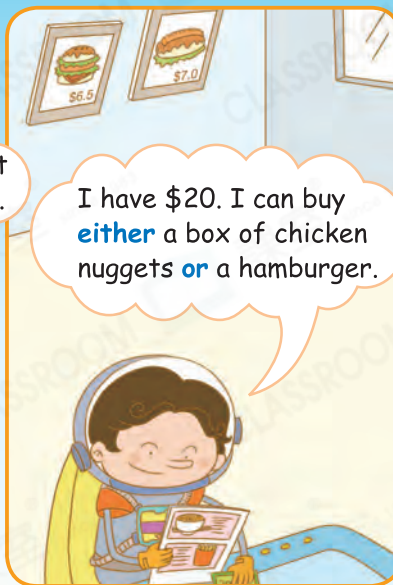

Neither Sam nor John is good at Art.

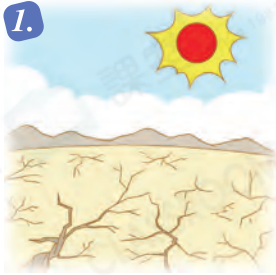
