## Banana Chocolate Mousse Recipe

## Ingredients:

- 6 oz chocolate chips
- 2 cups of water
- 3 eggs
- 1 teaspoon of sugar
- 1 banana



## Steps:

1. Place the chocolate chips in a bowl and heat it slowly over a pan of boiling water.
2. Stir the chocolate chips until they melt.
3. Move the pan away from the heat and let the chocolate cool down.
4. Separate the egg whites and egg yolks.
5. Add the egg yolks to the chocolate and mix them with a mixer.
6. Add the egg whites to the chocolate mixture and stir slowly.
7. Pour the chocolate mixture into three small cups.
8. Cover each cup with plastic wrap and put the cups into a fridge for two hours.
9. Put a slice of banana on top of each cup before eating.

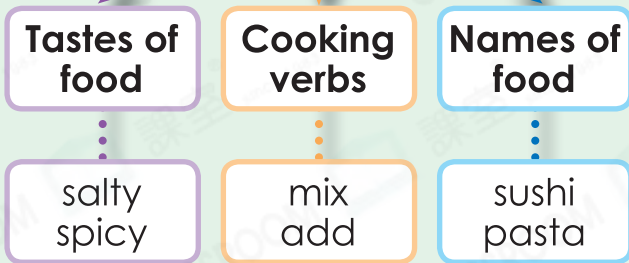
