This book is my favourite this year! It has many real-life examples. It is also useful and simple.



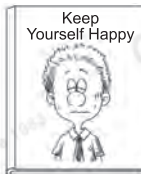
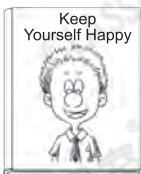

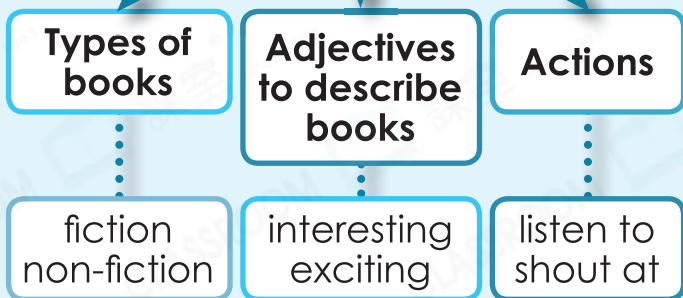
