10:00 **Hong Kong Geopark: Sharp Island (Kiu Tsui Chau), Sai Kung**

14:30 **Sai Wan Beach, Sai Kung**
Sai Wan Beach is one of the best scenic spots in Hong Kong. It is famous for its white sand and clear blue waters.

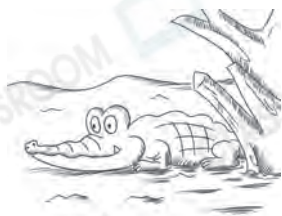
14:00 **Mai Po Nature Reserve, Yuen Long**

A 2-Day Sightseeing Tour in Hong Kong

Day 1	11:00	Sky100 Observation Deck, West Kowloon The observation deck is located on the 100 th floor of the International Commerce Centre (ICC). It is the highest deck in Hong Kong. It gives excellent views of Hong Kong Island and Kowloon.
	12:30	The Peak, Hong Kong Island Take the Peak Tram, the oldest public transport in Hong Kong, to get to The Peak. At the highest point of Hong Kong Island, you can enjoy beautiful views of the city and do some shopping.
Day 2	9:00	The Big Buddha, Lantau Island The Big Buddha is a large statue. Visitors have to climb 240 steps to reach it. Remember to try the delicious vegetarian dishes at Po Lin Monastery nearby.
	14:00	Tai O Fishing Village, Lantau Island The place is famous for its salted fish and shrimp paste. There is a nice spot to see the sunset. You can also take boat trips to watch Chinese White Dolphins.

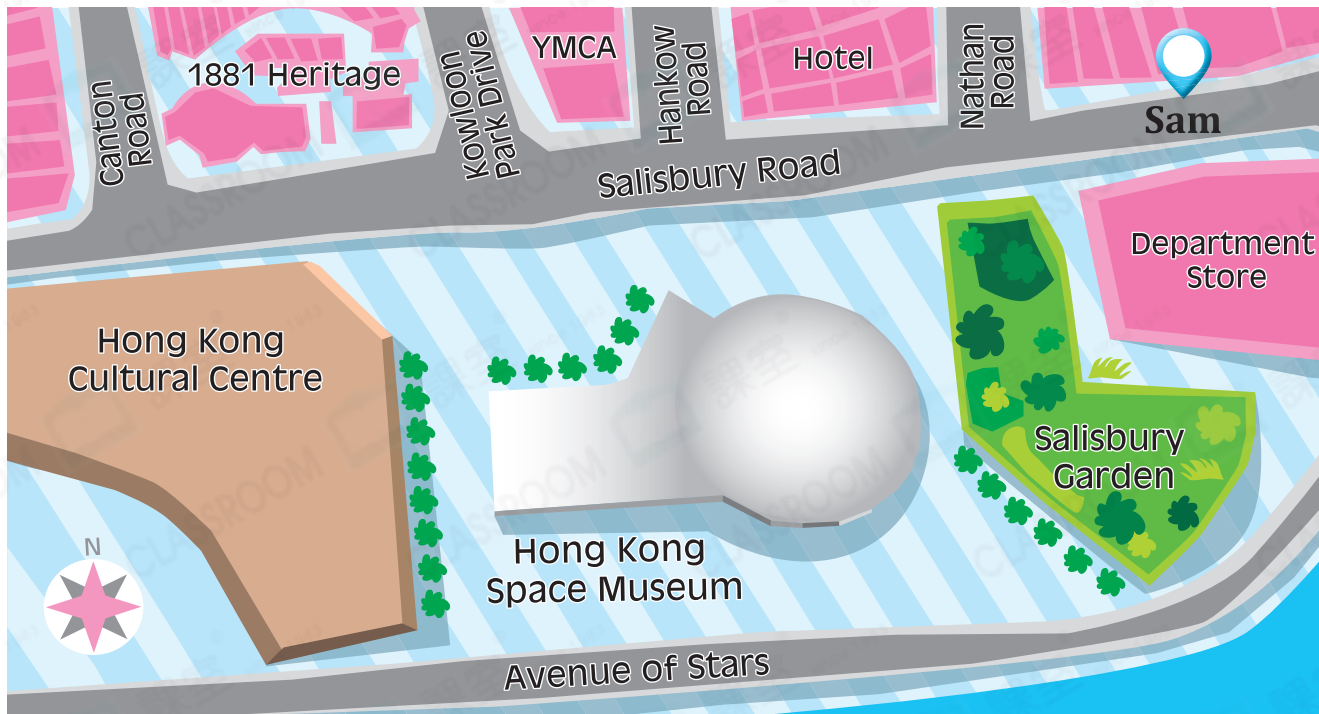

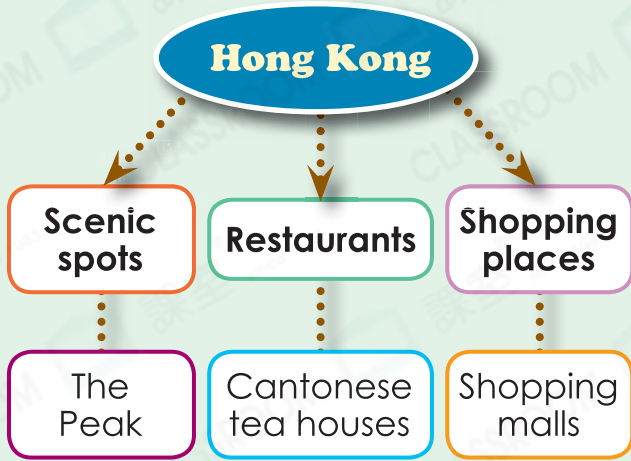

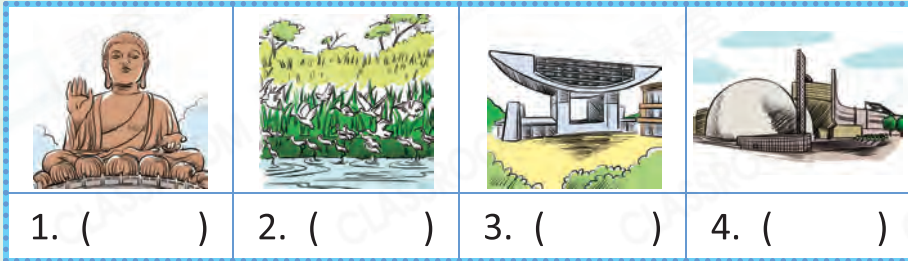
