## Cartoons

Nowadays, every child loves watching cartoons. Some may spend hours on them. Surprisingly, cartoons used to be for adults only!

The word 'cartoon' first came up in the Middle Ages. At that time, 'cartoons' were drawings prepared for a piece of art. In the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the meaning of the word changed. 'Cartoons' meant humorous drawings in a newspaper. They were often about news events, so usually only adults read them. From early 20<sup>th</sup> century onwards, 'cartoons' has had new meanings—comic strips or animated films. Cartoons became fun to children too. They were getting more and more popular.

In 1928, a man named Walt Disney created a cartoon called *Mickey Mouse in Steamboat Willie* in his studio. It is one of the earliest animated films. Disney made Mickey Mouse look like it was moving. The audience liked it very much. From then on, more and more people enjoyed cartoons.

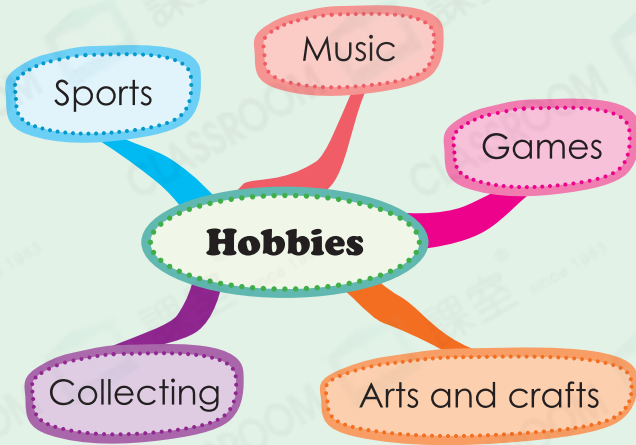
