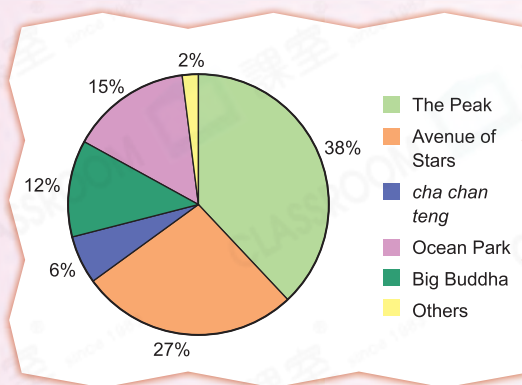
## Hong Kong Tourist Attractions

A survey on Hong Kong tourist attractions was carried out from 4<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> May. The purpose of this survey is to find out how popular some Hong Kong tourist attractions are. 2,320 tourists were interviewed.

The results of the survey show that tourists like The Peak the most. Nearly 40% of tourists choose it as their favourite attraction. The Avenue of Stars is also popular. 27% of tourists view it as their favourite. Ocean Park comes third and the Big Buddha fourth. Surprisingly, *cha chan teng*, a type of local tea restaurant, wins the fifth place. Eating in a *cha chan teng* becomes an eye-opener to many tourists. They love trying the pineapple buns and egg tarts.

From this survey, we can see that sightseeing spots are very popular among visitors. We therefore suggest that the government should create more of them to attract more tourists.

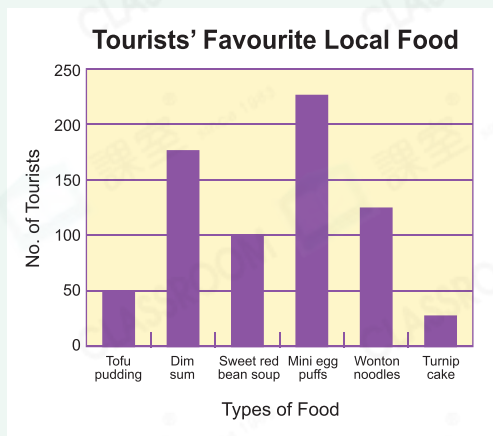

## Mini Egg Puffs: King of Local Food

In April 20XX, a survey was conducted on tourists' favourite local food. 700 tourists were interviewed in Tsim Sha Tsui. The results are as follows.

225 tourists choose mini egg puffs as their favourite local street food in Hong Kong. They find them tasty and convenient. Another 175 vote for dim sum as their much-loved local food. The snack-sized dim sum gives tourists chances to try more kinds of it. Wonton noodles hold the third place with 125 votes, while 100 tourists vote for sweet red bean soup. Visitors are amazed by the large number of dessert shops in the city.

Local delicacies continue to win the hearts of tourists, with the sweet and crunchy mini egg puffs topping the list. We should create more local dishes so that we can attract more tourists.

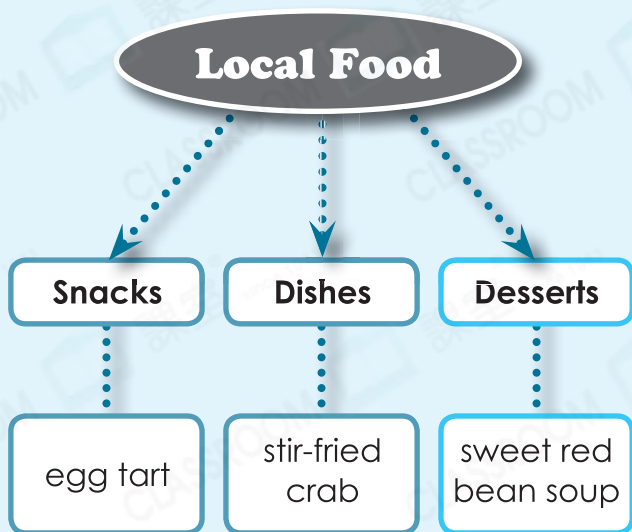

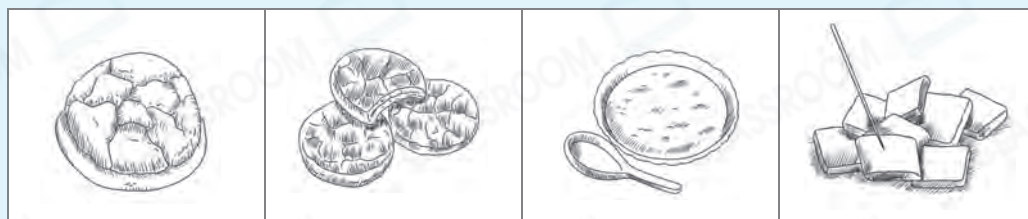
