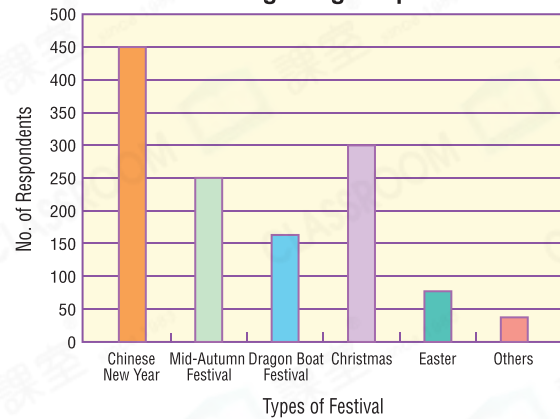
Favourite Festival in Hong Kong

Favourite Festival among Hong Kong People



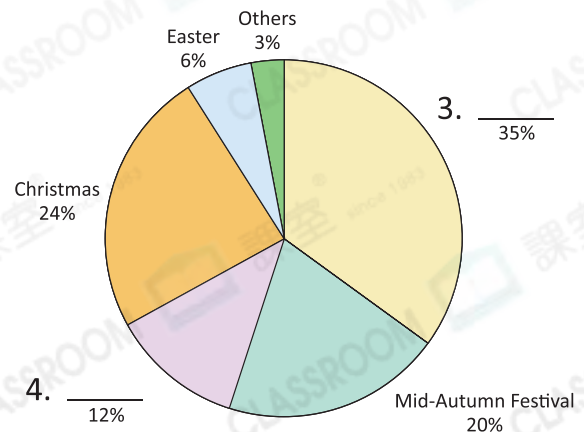
