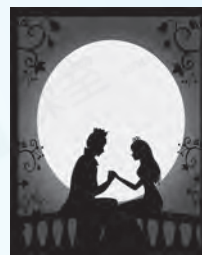

Act 1 Scene 1: At the clinic

Wendy is working busily at the computer. A man with a big blue umbrella walks into the clinic.

Wendy: Good morning! How can I help you?

Mr Watt: Hello. I am Mr Watt. I need to see Dr Yu now.

Wendy: Please take a seat. I will tell Dr Yu.

Wendy leaves and knocks on the door of Dr Yu's office.

Dr Yu: Please come in.

Wendy: Mr Watt is waiting for you outside. Should I send him in?

Dr Yu: Who is Mr Watt?

Wendy: He is the man with long curly hair and a narrow face. He came last Friday. Does it ring a bell? It was very hot that day, but he wore a long black coat.

Dr Yu: (*fearfully*) Oh, no. I don't want to see him.

Wendy: (*worriedly*) I understand. He's really strange. Last time, he asked me how much it cost to pull out all his teeth! But what should I tell him now?

Dr Yu: Um, send him in.

Mr Watt: Of course not! I really mean it.

Dr Yu: (*impatiently*) Teeth are not furniture! You can't move them around.

Mr Watt: I don't understand. Why not?

Dr Yu stands up and puts his hands on the desk.

Dr Yu: (*shouting*) Because teeth are teeth!

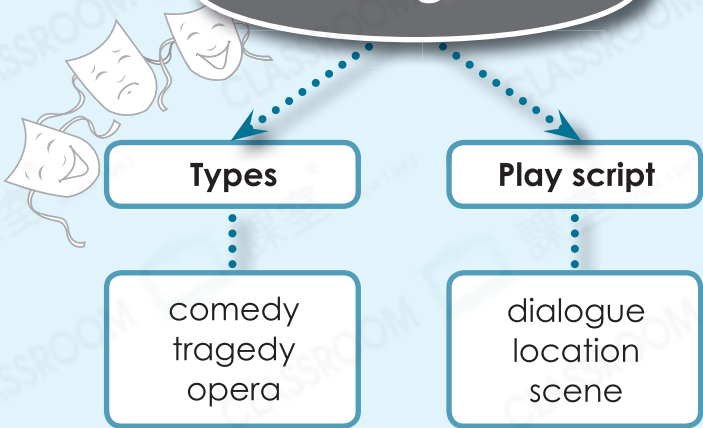
