

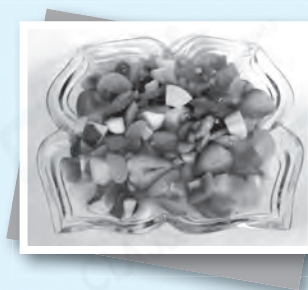
Fruit Salad

Servings: 3 adults

Ingredients:

- ◇ 2 apples
- ◇ 2 pears
- ◇ 4 strawberries
- ◇ 1 mango
- ◇ 3 tablespoons of raisins
- ◇ 1/4 cup of apple juice

Preparation time: 20 minutes



Instructions:

1. Peel and core the apples, pears and mango carefully so that there are no seeds.
2. Cut all the fruit into bite-sized pieces.
3. Put the pieces of fruit into a big glass bowl and mix them well.
4. Add raisins to the bowl.
5. Pour apple juice over the fruit mixture.
6. Cover and refrigerate it for 10 minutes. Serve chilled.

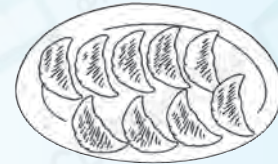

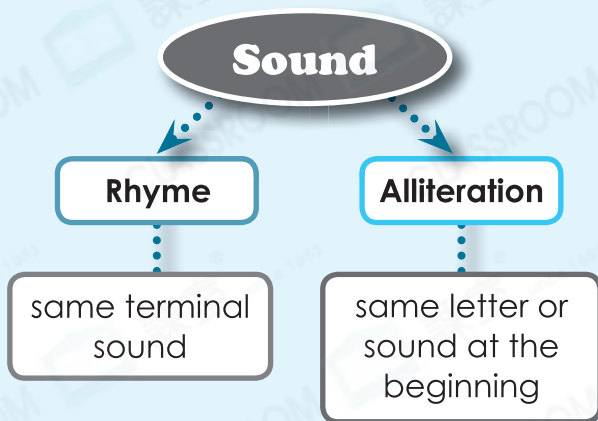
