



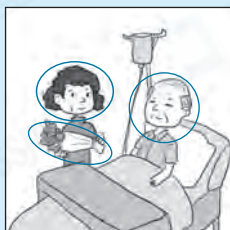
Pre-reading

S When a question requires matching **pictures** (e.g. activities) or **statements** (e.g. dialogues or situations) with specific information (e.g. time, dates, functions or titles), it is important to:

1. **circle the key features** in the pictures or **keywords** in the statements
2. **find clues** from the pictures or statements
3. **make a sensible guess** from the clues

Pay attention to the **time, place, people** and **what is happening** in a picture.

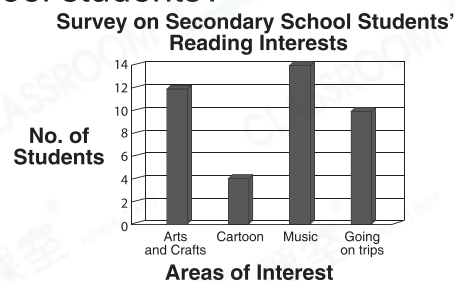
