S When a question asks **how a person feels**, it is important to:

1. listen carefully for adjectives describing feelings
2. pay special attention to the speaker's tone

e.g.	Speaker's tone	Possible feelings
😊	Happiness	<i>happy, excited, amused, touched, moved</i>
😞	Sadness	<i>sad, upset, worried, sorry, disappointed</i>
😲	Surprise	<i>surprised, shocked</i>
😌	At ease	<i>calm, relaxed, patient</i>
😡	Anger	<i>angry, mad, furious</i>
😱	Fear	<i>frightened, scared, afraid</i>
