



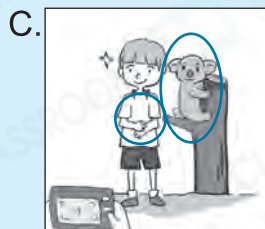
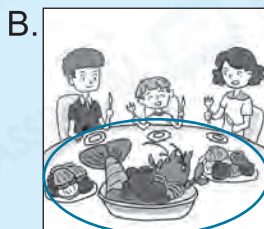
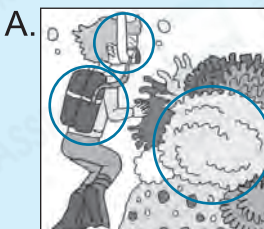
Pre-reading

2. pay attention to any **time** or **year mentioned**
3. be aware of **signpost words**
4. **study any given pictures** carefully
5. arrange the events or topics according to the **time they appear**

Pay attention to the **time**, **place**, **people** and **what is happening** in a picture.

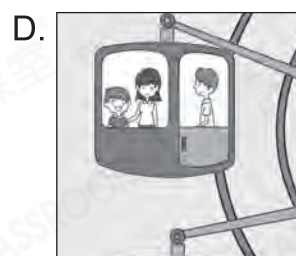


2. Dear Thomas,
