Life as a Comic Artist



Do you enjoy looking at the images in comics? Have you ever wondered who was behind these stunning pictures? They are actually created by comic artists!

Darwin Kim is a well-known Korean comic artist who illustrated the popular comic, *The Life of Captain Earth*. Since it became a hit, it has been adapted for film and television in Japan and America. 'I'm currently a comic artist working in London. My main job is to draw the characters and scenes in comics. Besides, I also have regular meetings with the script writers to discuss the plot and pictures of comics. **It** provides me with an opportunity to know more about their expectations, so that I can draw pictures that best portray the characters and represent the events in comics,' said Darwin.

To be a professional comic artist, you need to be good at drawing. You should be able to draw in different styles easily. Your illustrations need to 'speak for' the comic and help readers create clear and vivid images of the setting, characters and scenes in their minds. Therefore, it is important that you come up with original and refreshing ideas. It's surely the **most challenging task** to do. Besides, it is recommended that you study the artwork of other comic artists if you want to improve your drawing skills. However, attending an art school is optional as drawing skills can be acquired through other ways, such as watching videos online,' explained Darwin.

Being a comic artist is awesome! However, it can be tough at times as most comic artists are underpaid. They barely make enough money to support themselves. 'Some days, I feel really frustrated because I don't think I'm paid enough for all the hard work and effort I put into creating these pictures. But I would rather do my dream job for less money than do a job I dislike for more money!' added Darwin.
