Chinese Green Onion Pancakes

Chinese green onion pancakes, also known as *cong you bing*, are a traditional Chinese snack. It is popular in places like China, Malaysia and Singapore. Many tourists enjoy eating them when they visit these countries.

Chinese green onion pancakes are different from western pancakes. One of the major differences is that Chinese green onion pancakes are made from dough while western pancakes are made from batter. Also, western pancakes are usually pan-fried, while traditional Chinese green onion pancakes are deep-fried.

To make Chinese green onion pancakes, you need to mix flour, salt and water together to form a large dough. Let it rest for about fifteen minutes. Next, roll it out into a thin rectangular shape. After that, sprinkle some chopped green onions on it. Make it into a round dough bundle. Then, deep-fry it for two minutes over medium-high heat.

So why did people start making Chinese green onion pancakes? In the past, farmers in Northern China were very poor. They could only afford to eat vegetables they grew on their own. They wanted to make new dishes with just simple ingredients. Therefore, they used green onions and wheat to make pancakes.

A piece of tasty Chinese green onion pancake is golden brown in colour and has a crispy texture. Nowadays, many restaurants serve the pancakes with different types of sauces, for example, soy sauce and chili sauce. These give **them** even richer tastes. With or without sauces, it is still a delicious snack that everyone loves!

How is your school life in Hong Kong? Please write soon.

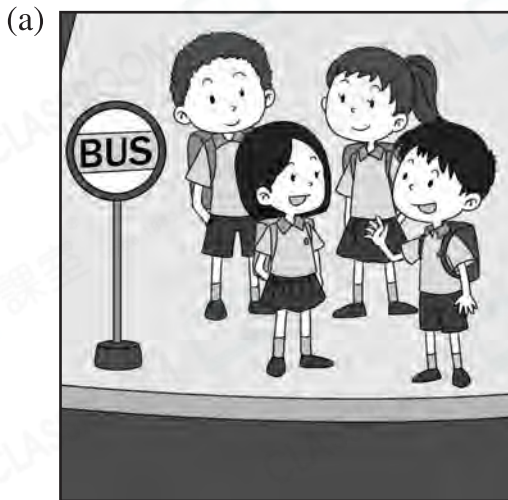
