24th December, 20XX (Monday)

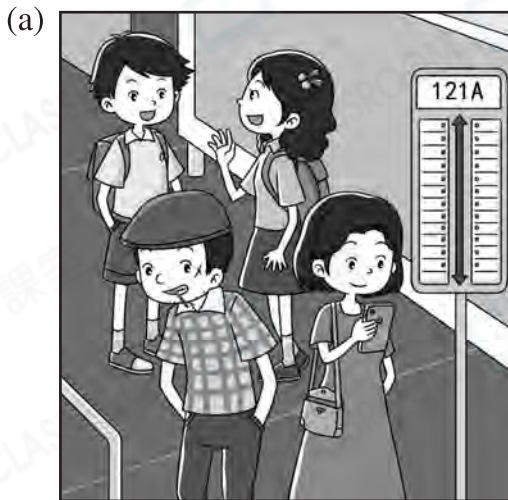
Rainy

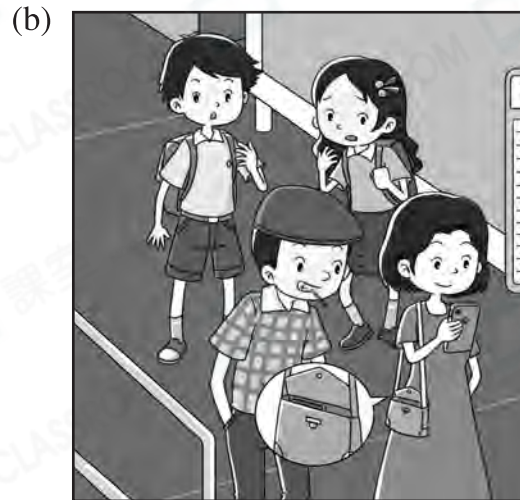

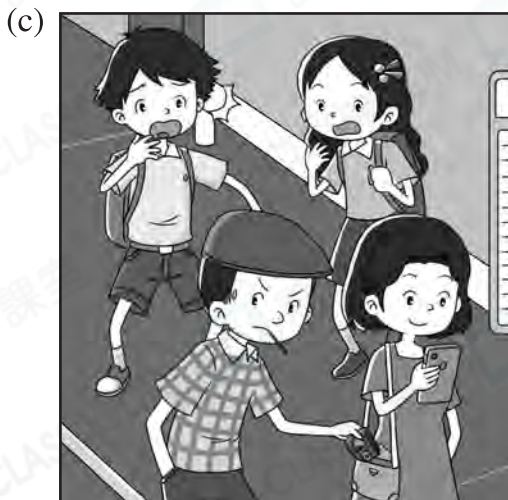

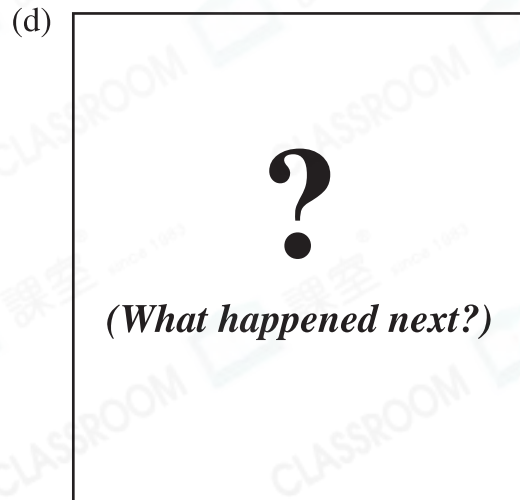
