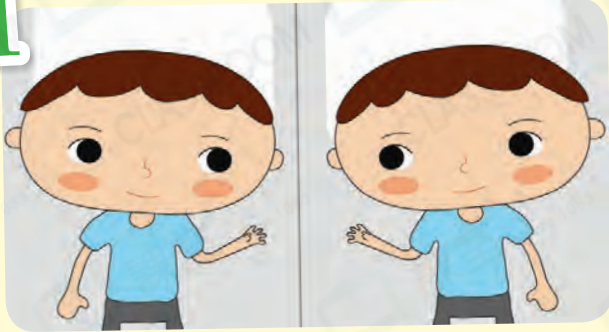


Sally is reading a story about three boys.
