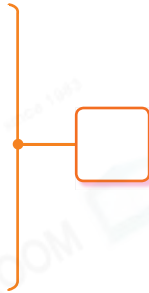

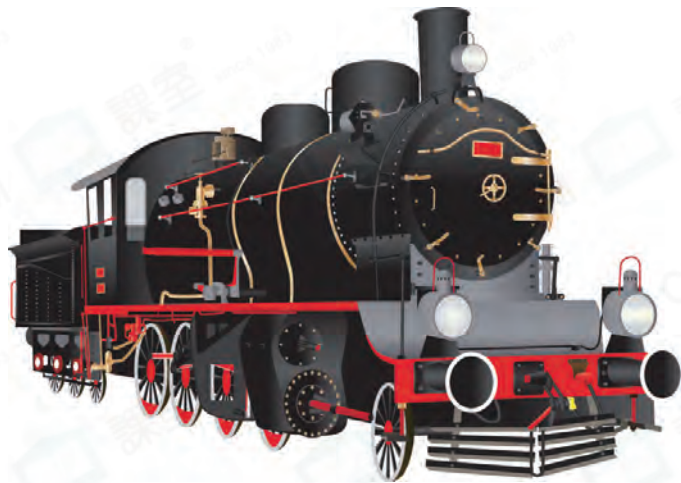
The Big Train

and steam.



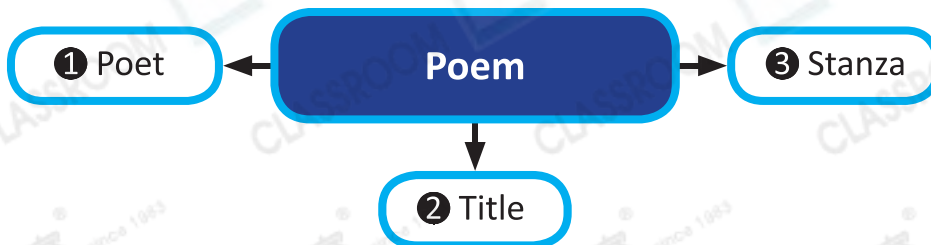
Too, Too, Too!
