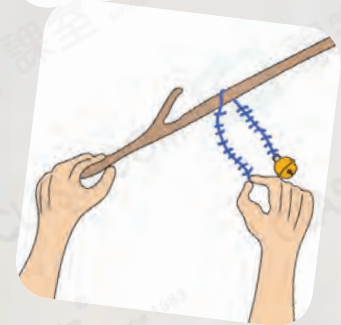
Flower Wind Chimes

What you need:

- ★ Cardboard egg box
- ★ Pipe cleaners
- ★ Twig
- ★ Pencil
- ★ Little bells
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Paints
- ★ Paintbrushes

How to do:

1. Cut the parts of a cardboard egg box into six little cardboard cones.
2. Cut around the edges of the cones to make petal shapes.
3. Paint the cones different colours.
4. Thread a pipe cleaner through a bell. Twist two ends.
5. Poke a hole in the cones with a sharp pencil. Thread the pipe cleaner through **it**.
6. Twist a loop on the other end of the pipe cleaner.
7. Hang the wind chime onto the twig.
