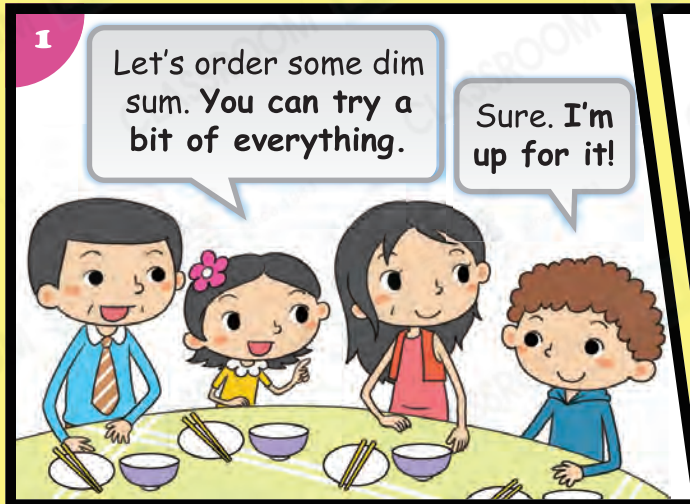


Phoebe is reading a comic strip about cultural shock.
