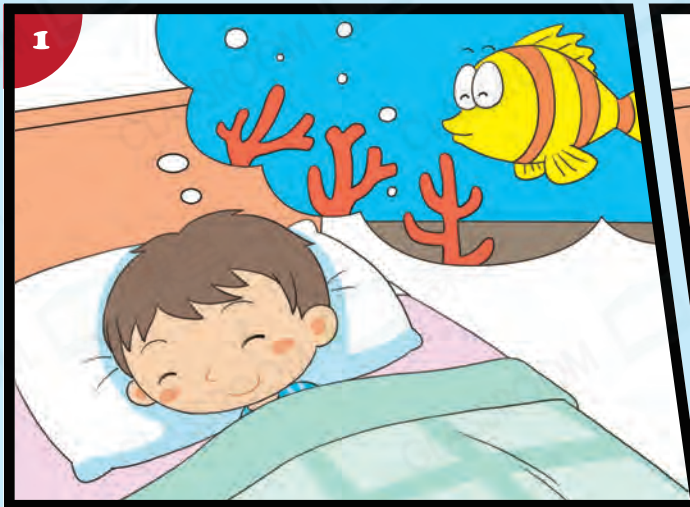


George is reading a comic strip about Kyle's dream.
