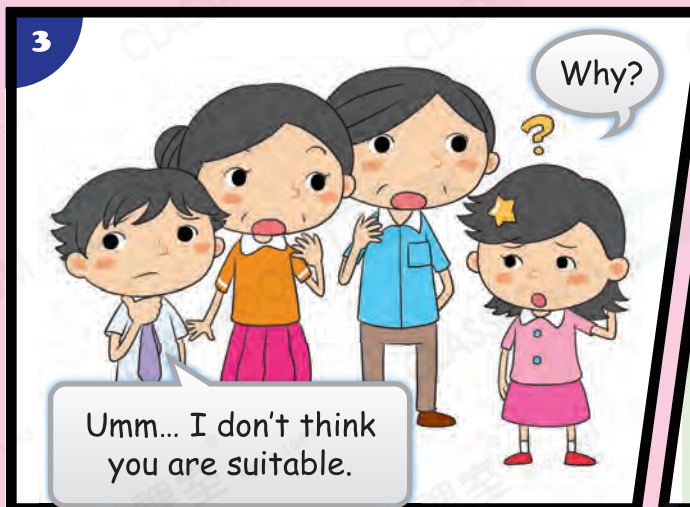
Tammy is reading a comic strip about a girl.
