

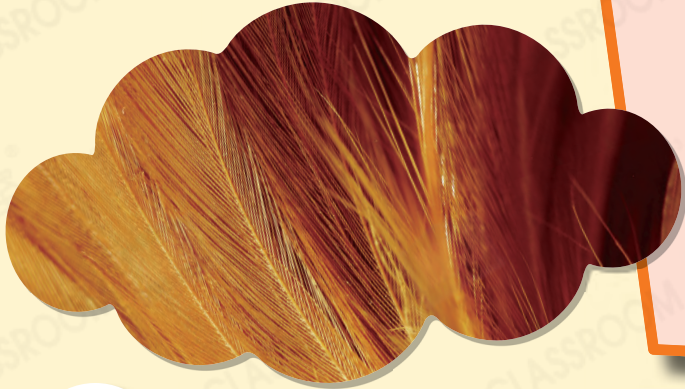
## Riddle

What is Mum doing?



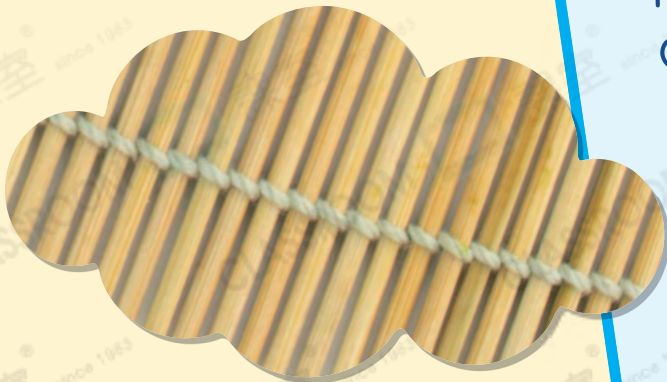
B
