Dear Carol,

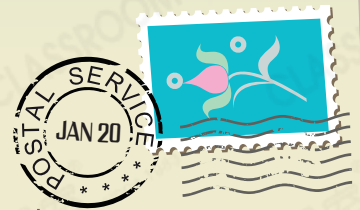
