- 10** Hong Kong International Airport is one of the world's busiest airports, but **it** is not the first airport in Hong Kong. Before it, Kai Tak Airport served many tourists and local people from 1925 to 1998. The airport was moved to Chek Lap Kok in 1998 due to rapid development of tourism.



▲ The old Kai Tak airport site is now used for cultural and recreational purposes.

15 Sea Transport

In the past, the public could only cross the Victoria Harbour by ferry. The Star Ferry, founded in 1888, has carried many passengers across the harbour. However, since the undersea tunnel was built in 1972, fewer people have travelled by ferry. **It** has now become a unique leisure activity for tourists and local people.
