## Yummy Peanut Butter Bars

[Servings: 6 Time needed: 60 mins]

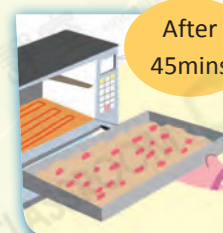


### Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups of unsalted butter    3/4 cup of sugar    1 egg (beaten)  
1 1/2 cups of flour    1 cup of peanut butter  
1/2 teaspoon of baking powder

### Steps:

- (1) Preheat the oven to 350°C.
- (2) Grease a baking pan by spreading a little butter and flour over it.
- (3) Mix the butter and sugar together with an electric mixer. Add the beaten egg and peanut butter. Mix them again.
- (4) In another bowl, mix the flour and baking powder together with a wooden spoon.
- (5) Slowly add the flour mixture to the peanut butter mixture.
- (6) Put the **dough** into the baking pan.
- (7) Bake it for 45 minutes. Cut it into bars before you serve it.

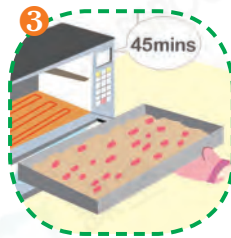
