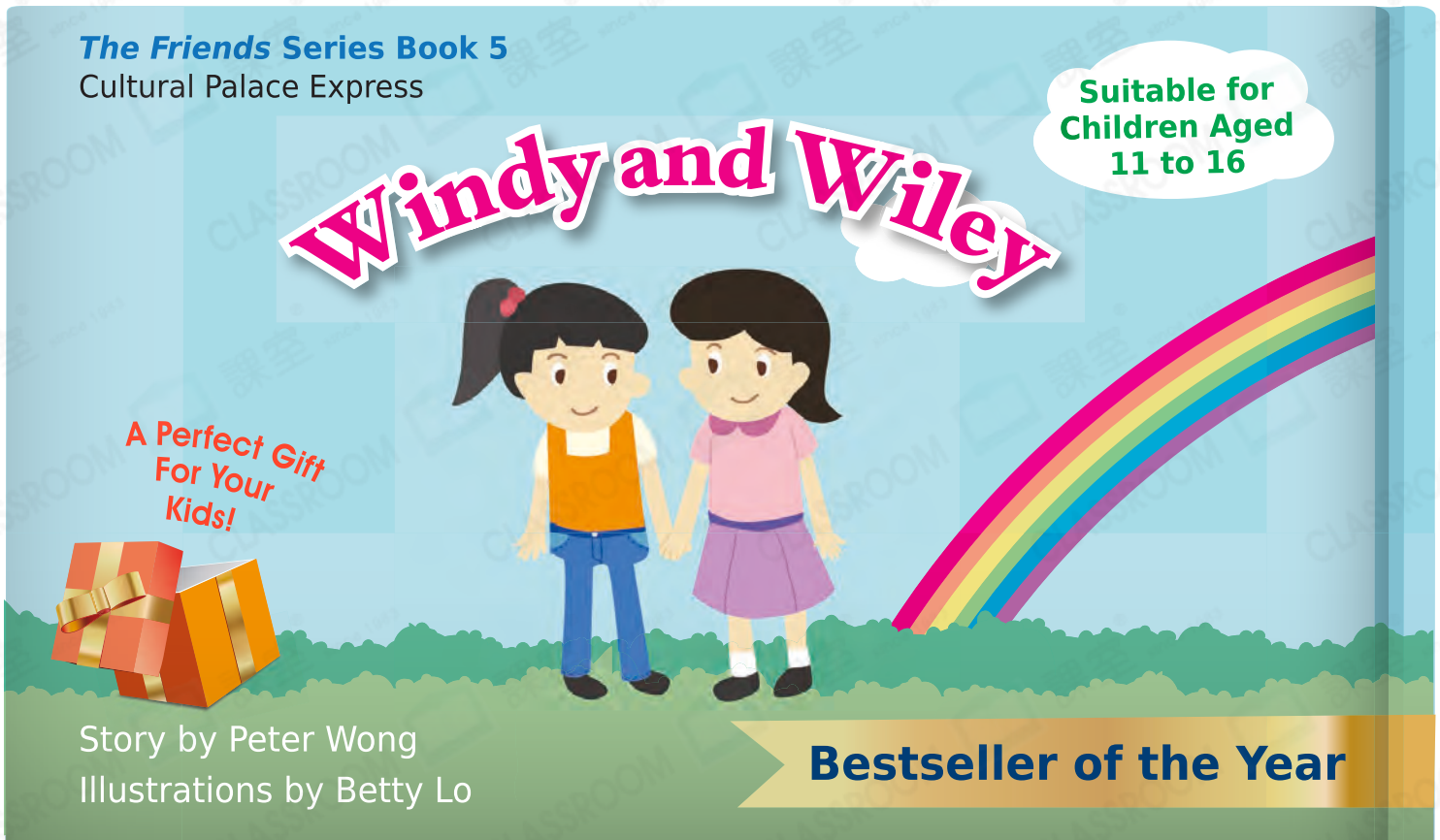


Book Cover
