Common Mistakes (Articles)

We put 'a' and 'an' before **singular countable nouns** only.


e.g. I can see **a bird**.

We do not put 'a' or 'an' before plural or uncountable nouns.

✗ I see **a flowers** in the park. ✓ I see **flowers** in the park.



✗ Connie has **a long hair**. ✓ Connie has **long hair**.
