### Common Mistakes

(Subject Pronouns + Possessive Adjectives)

We use **subject pronouns** to replace people, animals, things or places. We put them before the verbs in sentences.

e.g. Mum likes flowers. **She** likes daisies.

e.g. Ken and Jay sing. **They** sing happily.

We use **possessive adjectives** to show that people or animals own something. We put them before the things.

e.g. Mr Chan has a car. This is **his** car.
